*After this, Jesus traveled about from one town and village to another, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God. The Twelve were with him, 2 and also some women who had been cured of evil spirits and diseases: Mary (called Magdalene) from whom seven demons had come out; 3 Joanna the wife of Chuza, the manager of Herod's household; Susanna; and many others. Luke 8:1-3a NIV*

She Had F\_\_\_\_\_ Resources

*These women were helping to support them out of their own means. Luke 8:3b NIV*

It is good to recognize that Jesus not only gave ministry, He n\_\_\_\_\_ ministry.

- Hippolytus of Rome, a third-century theologian, called her “The A\_\_\_\_\_ to the Apostles.”

*Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. Matthew 6:21 NIV*

She was D\_\_\_\_\_ to Jesus

**-Mentioned in three gospels for being at the c\_\_\_\_\_.**  
(Matthew 27:56, Mark 15:40, John 19:25)

- *She was one of the women who was there in the background when he (Jesus) was crucified – She had more g\_\_\_\_\_ than most of them had. - Frederick Buechner*

**-Went to the tomb with absolutely no i\_\_\_\_\_ that the grave had been vacated.**

At least five times Jesus had said he would die and be raised on the third day.  
(Matthew 12:40, Matthew 17:22-23, Matthew 20:17-19, Mark 8:31-32, Mark 9:31)

**She Was the First to S\_\_\_\_\_ the Resurrected Jesus**

*13 They asked her, “Woman, why are you crying?” “They have taken my Lord away,” she said, “and I don’t know where they have put him.” 14 At this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there, but she did not realize that it was Jesus.*

Why do you think she did not recognize Jesus?

*15 He asked her, “Woman, why are you crying? Who is it you are looking for?” Thinking he was the gardener, she said, “Sir, if you have carried him away, tell me where you have put him, and I will get him.” 16 Jesus said to her, “Mary.” She turned toward him and cried out in Aramaic, “Rabboni!” (which means “Teacher”). John 20:13-16 NIV*

What made her recognize that it was Jesus who stood before her?

**She Was the First Missionary with N\_\_\_\_\_ of the Resurrection**

*17 Jesus said, “Do not hold on to me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father. Go instead to my brothers and tell them, ‘I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.’” 18 Mary Magdalene went to the disciples with the news: “I have seen the Lord!” And she told them that he had said these things to her. John 20:17-18 NIV*
